



KAA Spring Break Go Trip 2024

What is the purpose of this trip?

- To prepare the [Kids Across America](#) camp facilities near Branson, Missouri for a summer of ministry to inner-city kids.

What will we be doing in Missouri?

- Don't just have an ordinary spring break . . . have a ministry experience! On this Go Trip, we will travel to the Kids Across America camp near Branson to help prepare the camp facilities for a summer of ministry to inner-city kids. Past projects have included: clearing brush, landscaping, carpentry, power washing, and cleaning—all the fun stuff that city kids in North Texas don't usually get to do! Our team will have the opportunity to help “reset” that campgrounds for the campers coming this summer 2024.

Who can participate?

- Multi-Generational: Families (with children 8 years old or older), single adults, couples, and senior adults are all welcome to participate!
- Ages 8–17 must be accompanied by a parent or adult guardian.
- The trip is limited to 40 people.

Dates of the Go Trip: March 10–14, 2023

- Travel to KAA on Sunday, March 10. Please plan to arrive by 6 p.m. for dinner and evening orientation.
 - Please also note that transportation is not provided or included in the cost of this trip; you will be responsible for arranging your own transportation to and from Missouri.
- Workdays: March 11, 12, 13, and 14 (14th is a half-workday; we'll clean up in the morning then travel home)
- We will also have a half-workday on either Tuesday or Wednesday to allow free time to go to Branson, eat dinner out, tour around, etc.
- Depart on Thursday, March 14

What is the total fundraising goal for this trip?

- \$250 per individual or family unit
- \$50 per additional non-immediate family/guest of your family
- Examples:
 - If you are participating as an individual, your total is \$250

- If you are participating as a family unit and sharing a cabin, your total is \$250
- If you are participating as a friend of a family (participating as a guest of a family) your total is \$50 added to the family unit you are coming with.
- MUST PROVIDE FUNDS IN FULL before you leave for Missouri.
- This fundraising goal amount includes:
 - lodging in a cabin for you and your family, if applicable
 - meals from dinner on your arrival date through breakfast on your departure date
 - all supplies and activities
- Transportation is not included in the \$250 total, so you will need to plan and pay for your own travel arrangements to and from KAA camp. We also recommend you bring spending money to cover any additional meals and incidentals.
